1st World Poetry Competition "Manolis Aligizakis"

The International Art Academy invites entries from around the world for its 1st World Poetry Competition "Manolis Aligizakis".

GUIDELINES

The International Art Academy Poetry Competition "Manolis Aligizakis" is awarded to the three best, unpublished poetry collections. Deadline is March 31st, 2013 (postmarked date).

Participation is open to everyone, no restrictions based on age, nationality, location of poets. All submissions must be of unpublished poems and written in the Greek language.

Evaluation will be in two phases: first to establish the long list and second to select the finalists and winners.

Submissions have to consist of minimum 25 and maximum 35 useful poetry pages. If one poem is more than a page the same rule applies.

Submissions should be on page size 8 1/2x11 1/2, font size 12; pages must be numbered.

Name of the participant has to appear on the top-center of each page, just above the poem title and size of font is the same as that of the poems.

Submissions will be evaluated by a team of three judges (poetry instructors of the International Art Academy).

The Academy retains the right to publish poems of the awarded collections and some of the poems by the runners up in order to create a feasible poetry anthology.

Submissions which do not follow these rules to the point will be disqualified.

Mailed submissions will not be returned.
